Welcome! We are glad you want to join us for English/horse camp this summer! We look forward to having a great time. In addition to learning horsemanship, you will have the opportunity to practice and improve your English.

It may be important for you to understand that while everyone is welcome whatever his/her faith or church background, we will be approaching things from a Christian point of view. At times we will be reading from the Bible, and we will share about our lives and our relationship with Jesus Christ.

We will be learning from a natural horsemanship perspective, based on a partnership involving kindness, patience, respect and responsibility. During our camp we will endeavor:

1. To respect and honor each other, the horses, and God; to encourage and build up one another
2. Responsibility: God has given us dominion over His creation on earth, including His creatures. This privilege and freedom is a great responsibility, requiring us
 - to be diligent and trustworthy
 - to be wise and knowledgeable to the best of our ability

TEAMS

Working together in teams with a positive attitude and encouraging one another will be an important part of this camp. Campers will take part in riding and horsemanship activities, games, crafts, chores, music, devotions, large group activities, small conversation groups, English workshops and homework time (tutors available!) Campers and staff from different countries and backgrounds will be part of the camp.

FACILITIES & COST

Cost: 25000 HUF per camper registered by July 1. The camp will be held at the Györi farms in Lajosmizse. Meals and snacks Sunday evening through Saturday breakfast will be included as part of the camp program; if there are special dietary needs please inform camp staff and plan to bring alternate foods. Sleeping facilities: camping (teepees with wooden bed platforms or tents.) Shower and sanitary facilities available. Tax-deductible donations to help with the cost of the camps or provide scholarships for others welcome.
